

Laced Scarf



I was a brand new knitter when I designed this scarf. Inspiration came upon me when I discovered the beauty of handpun yarns from Rio de la Plata and Manos del Uruguay. The thick and thin nature of these kettle-dyed yarns contrast well with the smooth and shiny nature of satin ribbons. This simple yet very stylish knit will surely get you as many compliments as I have had.

LEGEND

[], ()	work instructions within brackets/parentheses as many times as directed	k2tog	knit 2 together
BO	bind off	P	purl
CO	cast on	ssk	slip, slip, knit
k	knit	st(s)	stitch(es)



LEVEL

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED SIZE

Width: 5in. (12.7cm)

Length: 60in. (1.5m)

MATERIALS

- Bulky yarn, 230yds (210m) or more for a wider or longer scarf.
- US 10.5 (6.5mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- 5/8" (1.59cm) wide Double-faced satin ribbon, about 2.5-3yds (2.29-2.74m)

GAUGE

22 sts x 18 rows = 4in. (10cm) in 1x1 rib

Using Other Yarns...

A great yarn to try for this scarf is Rio de la Plata Merino Pampa (100% merino wool). Adjust your CO and needles as necessary or desired.

(Sample uses 2 skeins of Rio de la Plata Yarn in Dusk Blue, #A34.)

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PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

- CO 25 sts

RIB PATTERN

- Rows 1 and 3: [k1, p1] for row.
- Rows 2 and 4: [p1, k1] for row.

EYELET PATTERN

- Row 1: [k1, p1] 4 times, k1, yo, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, ssk, yo, k1, [p1, k1] 4 times
- Rows 2 and 4: [p1, k1] for row.
- Row 3: [k1, p1] for row.
- Work rows 1-4 for eyelet pattern a total of 8 times — about 8.5”/ 21.6cm from CO edge; 8pairs of eyelets.

MAIN BODY

- Continue the 1x1 Rib by working Rows 1 and 2 of the Set-Up until scarf is 7.5”/ 19cm less than desired length
- Work Eyelet Pattern 8 times.
- Work Set-Up Rows 1-4.

FINISHING

BO loosely in pattern. Weave in ends, lace ribbon through eyelet holes.
