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Materials:

Size US-E/3.50mm Crochet Hook
Lion Brand Pound of Love - White
Caron Simply Soft - Black
5 - 1/2" Pink PomPoms
2 - 1/2" Black PomPoms
Pink Embroidery Floss
Black Embroidery Floss
2 - 9mm Safety Eyes
Aleene's Tacky Glue
Polyester Fiberfill
Blunt darning needle
Small Amount of Pink Felt

Abbreviations:

SC = Single Crochet
Ch = Chain
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Beg = Beginning
St(s) = Stitch(es)
2tog = Crochet 2 stitches together (decrease)
* = Repeat stitches from * to end of *
HDC = Half Double Crochet
DC = Double Crochet
TRC = Treble Crochet
SL ST = Slip Stitch

Pattern Notes:

- This pattern is worked in continuous rounds; do not join and do not turn.
Use stitch marker to indicate beginning of rounds.
- May not be safe for small children.
- **Yarns listed is what I used - size may vary with other yarns.**

Head:

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in second ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in second sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnds 7-12: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 13: *Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 14: *Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 15: *Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Fasten off, leaving a long tail; Position and insert safety eyes; stuff firmly.

Sew opening closed. Flatten bottom of body so doll can sit.

Hoodie:

With Black Yarn, Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in second ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in second sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnds 7-14: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 15: Sl st in next sc, work 1 HDC in next st, 1 DC in next st, 1 TRC in next st, 1 DC in next st, 1 HDC in next st, sl st in next st. (This will make the point on the hoodie). Fasten off; leave a long tail for sewing hoodie on head.

Ears: (Make 2)

With Black Yarn, ch 2

Rnd 1. Work 5 sc in sec ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in ea sc around = 10 sc

Rnd 3: Sc around

Rnd 4: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 5-8: Sc around

Rnd 9: *Sc in first sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 10 sc

Rnd 10-11: Sc around

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

To shape tip of ears, gently push the end of your crochet hook into ear to give the tip a slight point. Be careful not to poke a hole through the tip of the ear.

At this point, you will insert the head into the hoodie. Position ears on each side of hoodie. Make sure the point of the hoodie is on the front of the head. Sew ears on head. Sew hoodie on head. Weave in yarn. Glue the 1/2" black pompom on the tip of each ear - set aside and allow to dry.

TIP: Any time I work with gluing a small piece or spot, I always use a toothpick to apply the glue. This gives more control on the amount of glue you apply.

Now we work on the body.

Body:

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in second ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in second sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnds 7-11: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 12: *Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 13: *Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 14: *Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 15: *Sc in next sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 10 sc

Fasten off leave long tail; stuff firmly. Sew opening closed (this will be the bottom). Weave in yarn. Flatten bottom so doll can stand.

Now we will work on the collar.

Collar:

With Black Yarn -

1. Insert crochet hook on top of body - pull yarn and make a loop. Sl St loop to secure.



2. Insert hook through each st on top of body and sc around = approximately 7 sc around
NOTE: Depending on yarn you use the amount of sc around will vary - with the yarn I used, I got 7 sc around. My numbers are just approximates.



3. Work 2 sc in each sc around = approximately 14 sc
4. *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = approximately 21 sc
5. *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around (Work 2 sc in last sc) = approximately 30 sc



Now you will make the little points on the collar for the pompoms.

6. *Sl st next 4 sc, work 1 HDC, 1 DC, 1 HDC in next sc, sl st next 4 sc*, repeat from * around (You will have a total of 5 points).
Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.
Weave yarn to top of body. (You will be



using this piece of yarn to sew the head on to the body).

Now you will glue the 5 - 1/2" pompoms on each point. Apply a small drop of glue on to the tip of each crocheted point on the collar. Attach the pompom. Set aside and allow to dry.

TIP: To control the amount of glue applied to each tip, use a toothpick.

Apply the glue to the toothpick, then place the glue on the tip of each point on the collar.

You will cut out a small skull out of pink felt. My skull measured 1/2" across and 3/4" long. Make the skull proportionate to the size of the dolls head. Apply a small amount of glue to the back of the skull (use a toothpick to spread the glue) and attach to the front of the cap. Set aside and allow to dry.



Skull Pattern



Now we work on the arms and the legs.

Arms: (Make 2)

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in second ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in ea sc around = 10 sc

Rnd 3-12: Sc around

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Lightly stuff arms.

Legs: (Make 2)

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in second ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in ea sc around = 10 sc

Rnd 3-6: Sc around

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing. Stuff legs.

To Assemble:

1. Attach head to body.
2. Attach arms under the collar.
3. Attach legs.
4. With black embroidery floss, sew eyelashes (stitch just above the safety eye to give Kuromi a "bad" look)
5. With pink embroidery floss. Sew nose.

Your adorable Crocheted Kuromi Doll is complete!

Doll measures 6" tall from tip of ears to bottom.
