

Monogram B Dishcloth Pattern

Designed by Connie Haney © 2006

Loomed on 40 Peg Dishcloth Rake

Pattern uses 37 Pegs and 57 Rows

Finished Size is 12" x 12" using E-Wrap and Purl Stitches

Use capital O's to mark your progress!

Use a Crochet Cast on from Right to Left

Working yarn tail is now on your Left, start with your first row, which is Knit Across.

Pattern:

OOOOO Row 1. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 2. Purl Across

OOOOO Row 3. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 4. Purl Across

OOOOO Row 5. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 6. Purl Across

OOOOO Row 7. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 8. P4, K29, P4

OOOOO Row 9. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 10. P4, K29, P4

OOOOO Row 11. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 12. P4, K11, P15, K3, P4

OOOOO Row 13. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 14. P4, K10, P16, K3, P4

OOOOO Row 15. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 16. P4, K6, P6, K4, P7, K6, P4

OOOOO Row 17. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 18. P4, K5, P4, K9, P4, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 19. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 20. P4, K4, P4, K10, P4, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 21. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 22. P4, K3, P5, K10, P4, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 23. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 24. P4, K3, P5, K10, P4, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 25. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 26. P4, K4, P5, K9, P4, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 27. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 28. P4, K6, P4, K8, P4, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 29. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 30. P4, K10, P12, K7, P4

OOOOO Row 31. Knit Across

OOOOO Row 41. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 42. P4, K6, P5, K7, P5, K6, P4
OOOOO Row 43. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 44. P4, K9, P17, K3, P4
OOOOO Row 45. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 46. P4, K11, P15, K3, P4
OOOOO Row 47. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 48. P4, K29, P4
OOOOO Row 49. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 50. P4, K29, P4
OOOOO Row 51. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 52. Purl Across
OOOOO Row 53. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 54. Purl Across
OOOOO Row 55. Knit Across
OOOOO Row 56. Purl Across
OOOOO Row 57. Knit Across

End by taking each loop from right to left off of your rake using your crochet hook. Work a single chain between each loop. Knot at end and work tail strand under a few stitches.

All Knit Across Rows are worked from Left to Right
All Pattern Rows are worked from Right to Left



Scalloped Crochet Edge is One Row of Single Crochet and Second Row of Design Stitch
Size H Crochet Hook

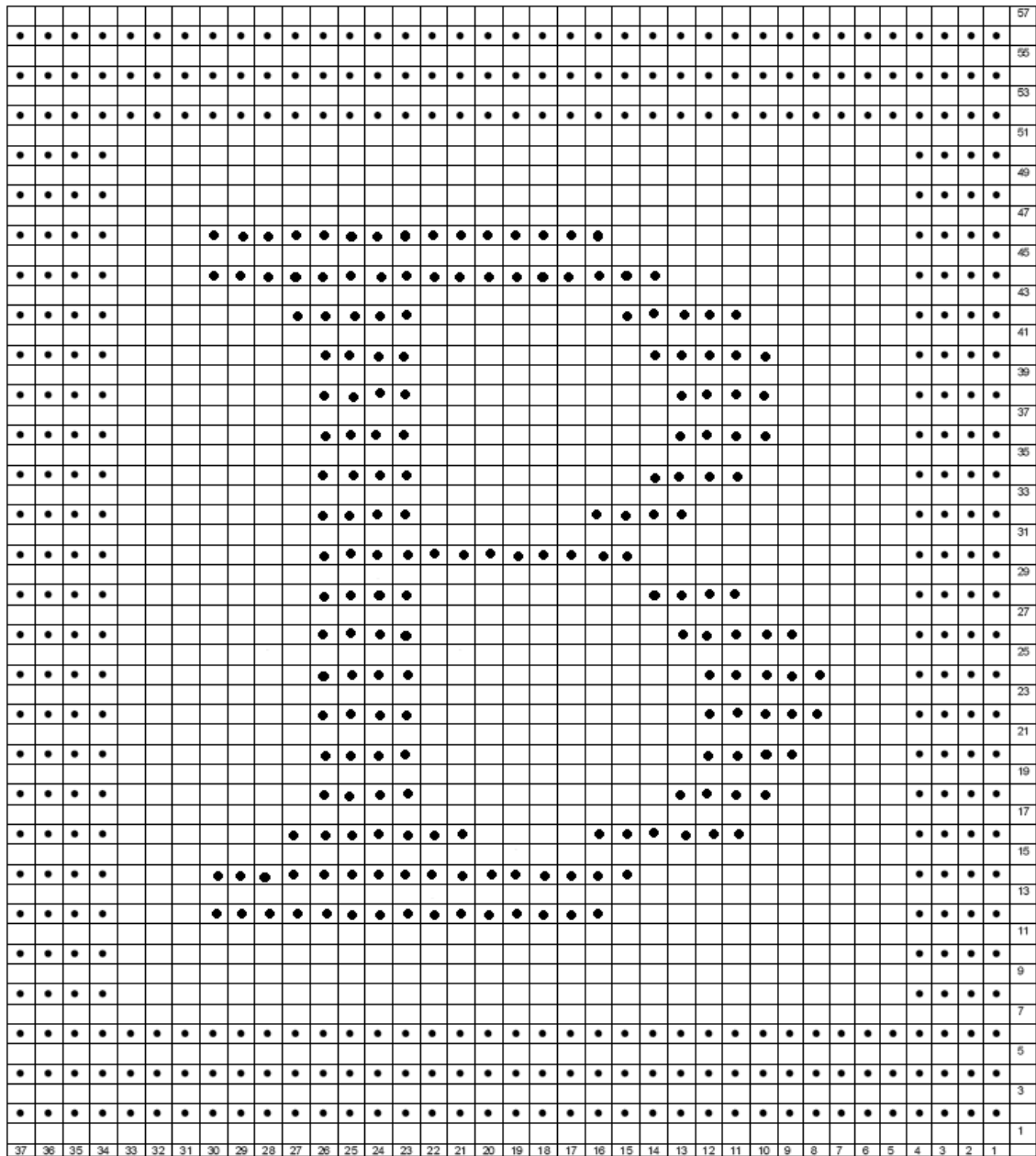
This scalloped edge is done in two rows; the first row all around is just single crochet.
 The next row will be your pattern that makes the scalloped edges.

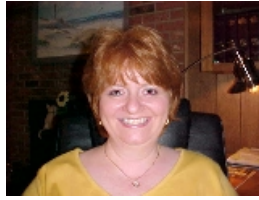
ch = chain sc = single crochet dc = double crochet st = stitch

Rnd. 1 Start by doing a single crochet stitch all around your dishcloth by making holes about 1/4" apart. You will end back at the corner you started on. Join with a slip st to first sc. ch 1

Rnd. 2 Sc into same sc as slip st, ch 3, 2 dc into same sc as slip st, skip next 2 sc, sc into next sc, * ch 3, 2 dc into same sc as last sc, skip next 2 sc, sc into next sc. Repeat from * all around then join with a slip st to first sc.
