

Crochet Flowers

Crochet this garden of flowers for decorating clothes and accessories or make a bunch of flowers as a gift to brighten someone's day. They also make great package trim!

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

Supplies: Cotton yarn in weight and colors of choice. Each flower only takes a few yds of yarn.

Appropriately sized hook for weight of yarn

Daisy:

- Round 1: In MC, Ch 2, 12SC in 2nd Ch from hook SS in first SC (12 st)
Round 2: Ch 3, DC in same st as Ch, DC in nxt st, *2DC in nxt st, DC in nxt st* rpt between * around, join with sl st (18 st)
Round 3: In CC, ch5, *sk 2 st, sl st in next st, ch 5* rpt between * 6 times join with sl st (6 ch sp)
Round 4: *(SC, HDC, DC, HDC, SC) in ch sp, sl st in DC directly below in round 3* rpt between * 6 times (6 petals)
Round 5: *2SC in nxt st, HDC in nxt HDC, 2DC in nxt DC, HDC in nxt HDC, 2SC in nxt st, sl st in nxt st* rpt between * 6 times (6 petals) BO



Daffodil:

- Round 1: In MC, Ch5, join with sl st to make a ring, 6SC in ring (6 st)
Round 2: Ch1, SC in same st as ch, 2Sc in each SC around, sl st in beg ch1 to join.
Round 3: In CC, sl st in nxt SC, *ch5, sk1, SC* 5 times, ch 5, sl st in beg sl st to join. (6 ch sp)
Round 4: Ch1, (SC, HDC, DC, HDC, SC) in each ch sp around. Sl st in beg ch to join (6 petals)
Round 5: Ch2, bring ch behind petal and SC in sk SC below on round 2, *Ch 6, SC in nxt sk st from round 2* rpt between * 5 times, Ch6, sl st in beg SC to join.
Round 6: Ch1, (SC, HDC, DC, TC, DC, HDC, SC) in each ch sp around. Sl st in beg ch to join. BO



Rose:

- Round 1: Ch5, sl st to make ring, 6SC in ring (6 st)
Round 2: Ch1, 2SC in ea SC, sl st in first sc to join (12 st)
Round 3: Ch4, *sk nxt SC, SC in nxt SC, Ch3* rpt bet * 5 times, sl st in beg ch to join. (6 ch sp)
Round 4: Ch1, (SC, HDC, SC) in ea sp around, sl st to beg SC to join (6 petals)
Round 5: Ch2, bring ch behind petal *SC in sk SC from Round 3, Ch4* 6 times, sl st in beg SC to join (6 ch sp behind the original petals)
Round 6: Ch1, (SC, HDC, DC, HDC, SC) in ea ch sp (6 petals)
Round 7: Ch3, bring ch behind petal *SC in same st as SC directly below on Round 3, Ch5* 6 times, sl st in beg sc to join (6 ch sp behind first two sections of petals)
Round 8: Ch1, (SC, HDC, DC, TC, DC, DC, HDC, SC) in ea ch sp. (total of 18 petals in all rounds) BO

**Tulip:**

- Round 1: Ch2, 6SC in second Ch from hook, sl st in first SC to join. (6 st)
Round 2: Ch1, SC in same st as Ch, SC in nxt st, *2SC in nxt st, SC in ea of nxt 2 st* rpt between * 2 times, sl st in first SC to join. (8 st)
Round 3: Ch1, Sc in same st as ch, *2SC in nxt st, SC in nxt st* rpt between * 3 times, 2SC in last st (12 st)
Round 4: Ch1, SC in same st as Ch, *2SC in nxt st, SC in ea of nxt 2 st* rpt between * 3 times, 2SC in nxt st, SC, sl st in beg SC to join (18 st)
Round 5: Ch 3 (counts as first DC), 17DC, sl st in top ch of beg ch3 to join (18 st)
Round 6: Ch1, *SC, DC, SC* 6 times, sl st in beg SC to join (18 st)
Round 7: Ch 1, *SC, (HDC, DC, HDC) in nxt DC, SC* rpt between * 6 times, sl st in beg SC to join. BO

Finishing note: this flower requires shaping. Starch if needed.

Ch.....Chain	SC.....Single Crochet	SS.....Slip Stitch
DC.....Double Crochet	MC.....Main Color	CC.....Contrast Color
sk.....skip	st.....stitch	nxt.....next
rpt.....repeat	ch sp....chain space	HDC....half double crochet
BO.....bind off	TC.....Treble crochet
